Introduction:

The internal complaints committee is a statutory body instituted with the key objective of prevention, prohibition and redressel of sexual harassment of women employees and students within the college.

Functions:

The main functions of the committee are as follows:

- 1. Grievance redressal of sexual harassment
- 2. Counseling services for complainants
- 3. Consultation/support services for college
- 4. Sensitization/ Awareness programmes for prevention of sexual harassment at the workplace.

Standard operating Procedure (SOP) on sexual harassment provides steps and standardized procedures to be followed when lodging a sexual harassment complaint at the workplace.

Constitution of the Internal Complaint Committee (ICC):

- It is constituted by 9 members:
- Presiding officer (women faculty member)
- NGO Representative (Committed of cause of women)
- Two faculty members (Nominated by college staff council)
- Two nonteaching staff (Nominated by director/ Chairperson Governing body)
- Three student representatives (elected members)
 - o UG
 - o PG
 - o PhD Scholar

Working of the committee:

- The committee works towards providing grievance redressal of sexual harassment case filed by any employee /student of the college against a male colleague/teacher/student.
- It organizes training programs/workshops for college staff and students to sensitize them and ensure knowledge and awareness of rights, entitlements and responsibilities enshrined in the act.
- It creates awareness about what constitutes sexual harassment including hostile environment harassment and quid pro quo harassment.
- The ICC of the college is prominently displayed on the website of the college with its annual reports uploaded on the same as well as names of the committee members with their contact details.
- Working of the committee is also included in the college prospectus.
- It is active on the social media for a wider reach among the students and staff with its purpose and functions prominently displayed.
- Elections are held every year to appoint student representatives from among the undergraduate, post graduate and research scholars.
